PRAYER OF CONFESSION: (Unison)

Gracious God, as we prepare to behold the birth of Jesus again, we are mindful of how we have failed to receive the

fullness of that gift. The story points us to your glory, yet we struggle to join in the song of praise and thanksgiving. We are distracted and confused, so focused on things of little significance that we overlook the good news of great joy that you have prepared.
